The Area

Area A

It is one of only two areas in the borough that are suitable for industrial use. At the moment it includes a recycling centre as well as 70 other companies, employing over 2,000 people. 1,000 of these jobs are directly or indirectly provided by the council and these jobs are being cut already. In the south-east corner there is a Site of Nature Conservation. Some of the buildings are not distinguished, are old and the businesses create noise and dust. 50% of the area is currently not in use. Other buildings have recently been renovated and businesses have spent tens of thousands of pounds on their premises.

Area B

There is no public access to this area and several railway lines run through it. It includes Drayton Park Station. There is also a London-wide Site of Nature Conservation Interest that includes railway signals.

Area C

Accommodates motor-repair garages and warehouse spaces. Arsenal owns part of the north area, which it uses for its shop. This area provides about 50 jobs, including the area's largest builders' merchant.
