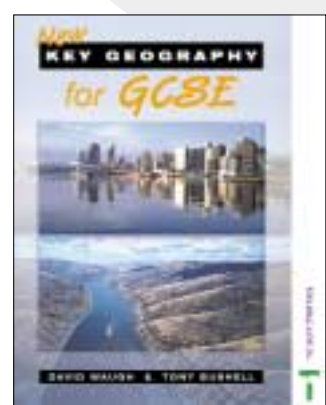
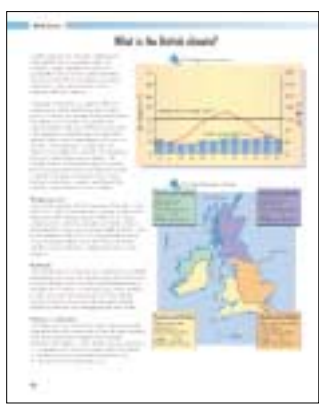


New for GCSE

Dear Colleague

The summer holidays have gone and doubtless you are back at school still battling with the changes to both the National Curriculum for Key Stage 3 and the GCSE Geography specifications.

Although these changes have not been as far-reaching as previous curriculum revisions, we felt that it was time to fully update the books in our Key Geography at Key Stage 3 and for GCSE series to ensure that they meet the changing requirements that you and your students need to meet. We have, therefore, responded to changes in both content and recommended teaching approaches so that the Key Geography series matches the Schemes of Work at Key Stage 3 and the new specifications at GCSE.

New for Key Stage 3

Following the publication of New Foundations and New Connections earlier this year, New Interactions will appear early in 2002. To go with the series, John Smith and David Gardner have completely rewritten the three Teacher Resource Guides to include new support material, worksheets, and activities to, among other things, help your students develop their ICT skills and to further encourage an enquiry approach.

New for GCSE

Resulting from feedback from teachers around the country, we have decided to combine the two books into a single volume of Key Geography for GCSE. Available early in the summer term of 2002, this new edition has been, where appropriate, revised and restructured to match the latest GCSE specifications, whatever specification you currently teach or decide to change to in future.

At Key Stage 3 and at GCSE, we have:

- left unchanged those areas of our earlier books where the content and teaching approaches have remained the same in the new specifications for each level
- updated events, data, terms and attitudes whenever and wherever we felt it necessary or desirable
- added new material and various teaching approaches to suit the changing nature of our subject and the requirements of the National Curriculum and GCSE examinations.


Additions to the books include increased emphasis on topics such as environmental change, sustainable development and interdependence. There is also a new enquiry at the end of each chapter in the Key Geography at Key Stage 3 books and a comprehensive glossary and skills section at the end of the GCSE book.

We hope that your students will find the new editions rewarding and exciting to use and that you, as their teacher, will find that they save preparation time, suggest a range of teaching techniques and enable you to gain the highest possible grades for your students.

We are confident that these new editions will prove a flexible and affordable way to cover all your Key Stage 3 and GCSE requirements for the next few years. Good luck!
