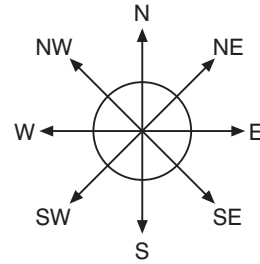


What is London like?
