

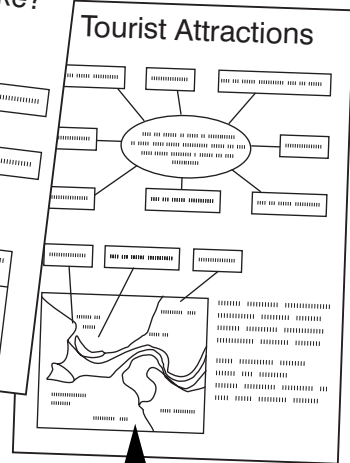
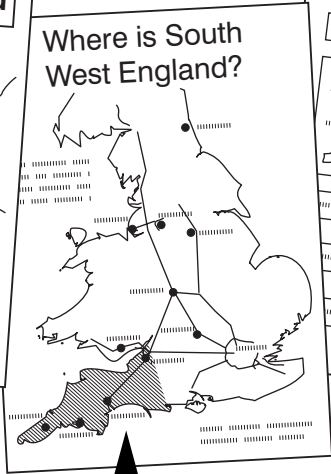
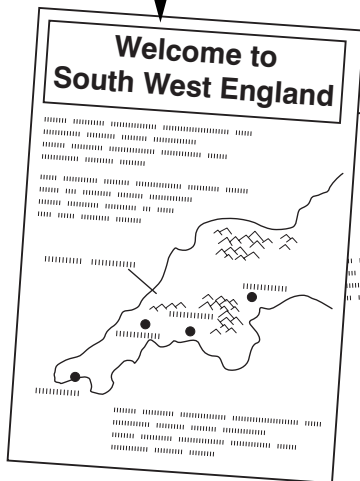
# South West England: information leaflet

South West England is one of Britain's most popular tourist areas. Your task is to provide an information leaflet for people visiting the area. Your leaflet should be interesting, attractive and informative. You may want to produce the leaflet on a computer to make it look more professional.

- 1**
- You will need to design a cover page.
  - Think of a good title for your leaflet.
  - Use photographs, drawings or maps to make the page attractive, interesting and colourful.

- 3**
- Next you should describe the basic geography of the area.
  - You will need to use maps and labelled sketches or photos in this section.
  - Try to produce a page or two on the physical features, such as the landscape and climate.
  - Also include information on the human features, such as main towns and roads.



- 2**
- You will need to describe the location of South West England.
  - You should use a labelled map here and write a short description.
  - Find out which motorway can be used to reach the area, and include that in your writing.

- 4**
- Finally, you should describe the tourist attractions of the area.
  - You could use maps, sketches, travel brochure photos, lists, writing or star diagrams here.
  - Try to sort your work under different headings, such as seaside, countryside, historic, etc.
  - Suggest things to do on wet days as well as on sunny days.
